

put in new \$540,000 to administer the new tax law. For the items originally listed by the governor, the total was \$1.1 million, or about 2 1/2 per cent, below the chief executives recommendation.

In all but a few instances, the Senate rejected amendments and kept the bill as recommended by a joint subcommittee of who have been studying the subject nearly six months.

The subcommittee lost when the Senate voted to give the Commission on Employment of the Handicapped \$29,340 a year. It now receives \$15,000 annually, and the subcommittee had recommended \$23,040.

Another subcommittee recommendation fell when the Senate voted to raise pay of Supreme Court justices, instead of keeping them at \$20,000.

The bill would make no change in pay of the state health commissioner, who receives \$22,500 a year, and the public safety commissioner, who gets \$15,000.

The governor's salary would go up from \$25,000 to \$30,000 a year. He would continue to receive \$5,000 annually for expenses.

the next highest paid is the attorney general, whose salary goes up from \$16,500 to \$17,500 a year.

A \$1,000 increase, to \$16,000, was included for the secretary of agriculture, the state auditor, the state treasurer and the secretary of state.

The bill called for the salary of the state superintendent of public instruction to increase from \$18,000 to \$20,000 a year, but an amendment allows the State Board of Public Instruction to give him an additional \$2,500 a year from any available federal funds.

Others with pay raises in the bill include Liquor Commission members, from \$10,000 to \$12,000 a year; Commerce Commission members, from \$12,000 to \$13,000 a year; the industrial commissioner, from \$12,000 to \$13,500 annually; the labor commissioner, from \$9,000 to \$12,000 a year; Tax Commission members, from \$12,000 to \$13,000 each year; the director of the Commission for the
