AUDUBON — Contests for the board of supervisors and sheriff will enliven the Democratic party primary election on August 1 in Audubon county, but no strictly local contests appear in the Republican primary.

Two incumbent supervisors, both Democrats, are seeking reelection, along with a third candidate. The incumbents are Frank Campbell of Audubon, and Russell Clemens of Kimballton.

The race for state representative in the general election will carry considerable interest in Audubon county. The 56th district is made up of 11 of the 12 townships in Audubon county, plus parts of six other counties.
