Carroll girls capture second win

The Carroll girls took revenge for an 8-4 loss earlier this season for their second win as they narrowly edged Lake City 6-5 Monday night.

Both teams played tight ball all evening, with the Tigerettes committing just five errors and pitcher Debbi Watts walking only one Eagle.

Lake City nearly matched the Tigerettes' fine performance, but pitcher Sarah McCrea slipped up too often in the neck-and-neck contest, despite striking out four batters and allowing nothing better than a single from Carroll.

Of McCrea's four walks, two Tigerettes made it home and Gloria Gipson, the only girl hit by a pitch, scored Carroll's only run in the first inning.

The score was never more than two runs apart throughout the game, with the lead changing hands several times.

Lake City got on the scoreboard right away in the first inning, pulling in two runs.

But the Tigerettes answered with a run of their own when McCrea walked Maria Vanderheiden with the bases loaded.

The Eagles failed to respond in the second inning as Carroll, now 2-7 on the season, pulled in three runs to take a 4-2 lead.
