

Carroll falls 5-4 to Atlantic

Playing its third game in four days, Carroll High came up short in a 5-4 loss to Atlantic Friday night at Carroll Stadium.

Chase Steinkamp suffered the loss for the Tigers, now 2-1 overall, in five innings of work. Steinkamp gave up five runs (2 earned) on six hits, walked two and struck out three. Ben Gossett pitched two innings, giving up no runs on one hit with no walks and one strikeout.

Nick Behm went 2 for 3 at the plate for Carroll with a double in the first inning. Gossett was 2 for 4 with a RBI single in the second. Matt Fleshner was 2 for 4 with a two RBI home run in the third inning.

"It was a pretty good week for us," Carroll coach Dirk Troutman said. "We didn't play especially well, but we got some good hits, we totaled eight hits, which is good against good pitching. We see some things we need to work on in practice. We feel good going into the conference season next week."
