

Carroll shutout by Perry in league play

PERRY - Carroll struggled at the plate with just two hits and lost to Perry in Raccoon River Conference baseball Wednesday, 9-0.

Brock Bengtson and Derek Major each had a base hit for the Tigers, now 9-9 overall.

"We had a couple defensive letdowns and let ourselves down at the plate," Carroll coach Dirk Troutman said. "We need to work on that here in the next few games."
