

Tigers win over Webster City

WEBSTER CITY - Carroll defeated Webster City 14-1 in non-conference baseball Tuesday night.

The Tigers opened the game up with five runs in the fourth inning. They plated seven runs in the sixth.

Addison Patrick went 3 for 4 at the plate for Carroll. Derek Major was 2 for 2 and Jesse Ayers 2 for 3. Michael Dirks and Tyler Tuel each drove in two runs.

Tuel got the win in five innings of work, giving up one run on two hits and striking out six. Kyle Christensen pitched one inning and gave up one hit and had one strikeout.

"The kids really hit the ball really well and had a big fourth inning with five base hits in a row," Carroll coach Dirk Troutman said. "Tyler Tuel pitched five outstanding innings on short rest, which we needed with some pitching shortages, that was big for us. The kids are playing well for us and we hope to continue that."
