Freshmen Pace Carroll Win, 3-2

Brad Wuertz — were instrumental in Carroll's dramatic 3-2 triumph over city rival Kuemper here Saturday night.

Edwards was the big hero as he singled home Wuertz with the winning run with two out in the bottom of the seventh.

Petersen had earlier singled off of losing pitcher Al Kohorst. Then Wuertz pinch-ran for Petersen.

Then sophomore center fielder Todd Buck singled, his third hit of the game, to put Wuertz on third.

Then Edwards delivered his game-winning hit to give the Tigers a 7-4 overall record and 3-3 Midwest Conference Eastern Division mark.

The loss for Kuemper, all but killed their hopes for a

chance at the conference championship. They now stand 6-7 in all games and 4-2 in loop play.

Kuemper jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the first as Russ Rupiper reached on an infield error.

Rupiper moved to second on a pass ball and scored on Mike Gute's single.

Carroll grabbed the lead in the third as Jim Petersen reached on an error and Buck singled.

Edwards then laid down a perfect sacrifice bunt to move

the runners up to second and third.

Then winning pitcher Eric Siemer slammed a two-run single.

Kuemper then tied things at 2-2 in the fourth as Marty Meshek reached base on an error. Then singles by Brian Tigges and Kohorst brought in the run.

Both clubs are in action tonight at 8 p.m.

Carroll travels to Perry and Kuemper entertains Denison.

Early Burst Sparks Kuemper Past Scrappy Lake City, 6-3

Mike Gute scattered five hits and struck out 13 as Kuemper turned back scrappy Lake City here Friday night, 6-3, in Midwest Conference Eastern Division play.

The Knights jumped out to a 6-0 bulge in the first two innings, then had to hold off the Eagles who came back in the sixth and threatened in the seventh.

In the opening inning off of Lake City losing pitcher Jay Yunek, the Knights scored four times as Larry McLellan walked with one out. Then Gute singled to left. An infield hit by Craig Bellinghausen loaded the bases.

Then McLellan scored on a pass ball for the first run and the second run scored when Rick Friedman walked with the bases full.

Tim Roetker's two-run single then scored Bellinghausen and Joe Roetker to up the lead to 4-0.

Two costly Eagle errors

helped Kuemper go to a 6-0 lead in the second as McLellan and Gute singled with one out. After McLellan was forced out, a fielder's choice and two infield errors brought in Gute and Bellinghausen.

An infield hit by Larry McCaulley and two Kuemper errors along with a run-scoring single by Brian Johnson gave Lake City their three runs in the sixth.

In the seventh, Gute walked leadoff batter Randy Winter. After McCaulley struck out, Mark Richardson singled sharply to center.

But Gute got strong and struck out Dan Conrad and Dave McIntire to end the game.

Kuemper won the junior varsity game, 8-2, in six innings. Ken Nurse pitched a two-hitter and had a no-hitter going through the first five frames.

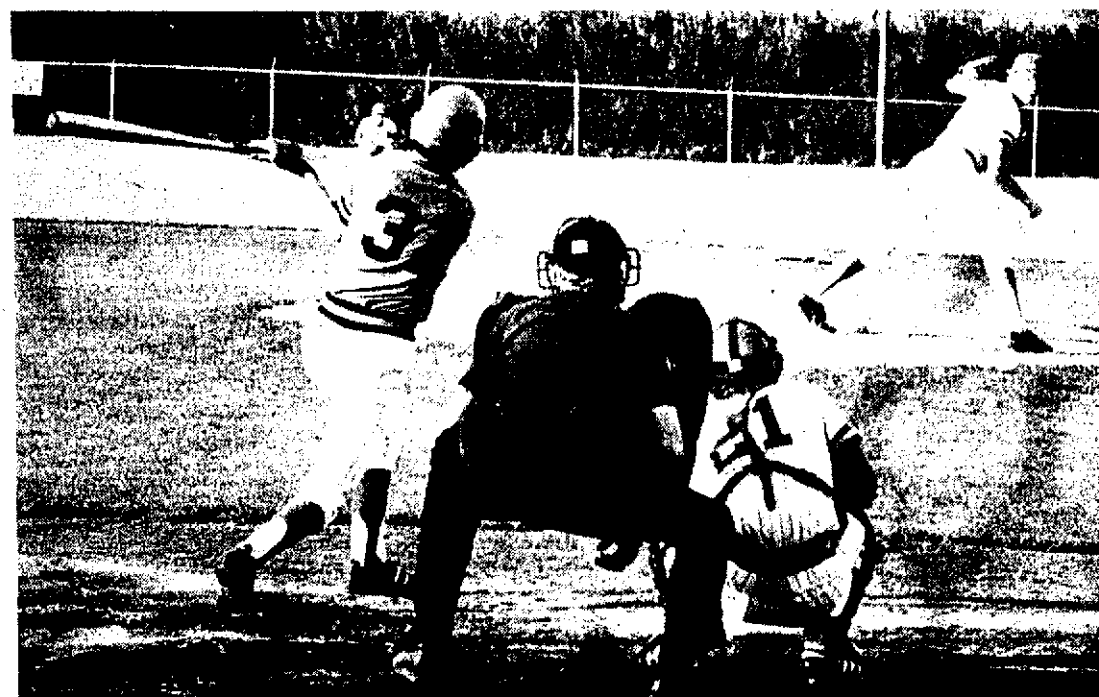
Marty Meshek had two hits and three runs batted in and

Pettitt Fires Four-Hitter as Tigers 'Walk' by Trojans

SCRANTON — Todd Pettitt fired a four-hitter and Carroll capitalized on 16 Scranton walks to whip the Trojans here Friday night, 9-1.

The Tigers didn't waste any time in beating the Coon Valley Conference member as they scored five times in the first.

The big hit in the first was Eric Siemer's two-run single after Brad Edwards had walked and Ron Bernholz had doubled.

Carroll's other first inning runs came home on a bases loaded walk to catcher Gary Luchtel, a sacrifice fly by Jim Mollitor and a fielder's choice by Jim Petersen.

The Tigers made it 7-0 in the second as Pettitt laced a

two-run double and the winners added their final runs in the third on a sacrifice fly by Siemer and another bases loaded walk by Luchtel.

Pettitt, in winning for the second time this year, fanned seven and was only in serious trouble in the sixth and seventh frames.

In the sixth, Scranton got their lone run on a fielder's choice by Lawton which scored Neary who had doubled.

In the seventh, Scranton loaded the bases, but Pettitt got Juergens to ground out to end the game.
