

Tigers Run Streak to 8-0

Carroll High ran away with the game Friday night whipping Manning, 14-2, and upping their winning streak to 8 games.

Those attending the game here saw a five-inning slugfest against a young Manning team that has yet to win a game this season.

Tiger hitters brought in nine earned runs. Mark Steffes was credited with the evening's big

hit — a second inning inside-the-park two-run homer.

Carroll ran into trouble in the second inning allowing two Manning runners to score on the errors. Following the inning, however, only one Manning player got on base the rest of the game.

Sophomore Brad Edwards, on the mound for the first time this year, gave up only one hit, struck out seven and walked

one.

Mark Arp, pitching three and one-half innings for Manning, walked 11 Tigers, giving up five hits and striking out one.

Arp was relieved in the fourth after walking three straight, by Scott Stripling who executed a double play and struck out one.

Carroll probably set some kind of record for stolen bases with Tigers heisting eight during the evening.

Two runs were also scored due to wild pitches.

Tiger Coach Ted Edwards emptied the bench before the game ended.

"After four close ones we needed this one," said Edwards referring to previous error-filled contests against sometimes difficult competition.

Carroll goes on the road Monday night facing Midwest Conference foe Jefferson.

The tournament was shortened because of rain. Mr. Bubbles finished with a 3-0 record; Willey Giants at 3-1; Bowlerama at 4-1 and Roselle Stars at 3-2.

MARSHALLTOWN — Six teams are left in the Matins Kiwanis 16 inch slow pitch tournament here.

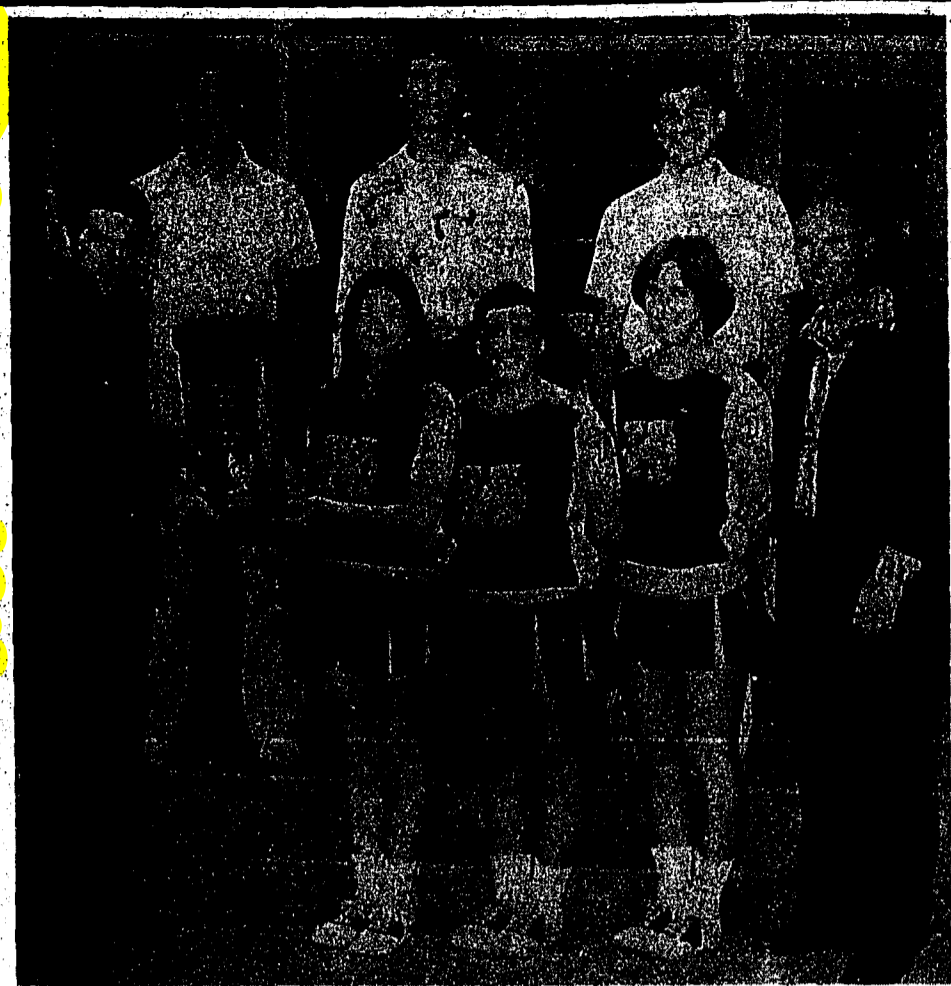
The tournament, shortened by rain Sunday, will resume Saturday at 3 p.m.

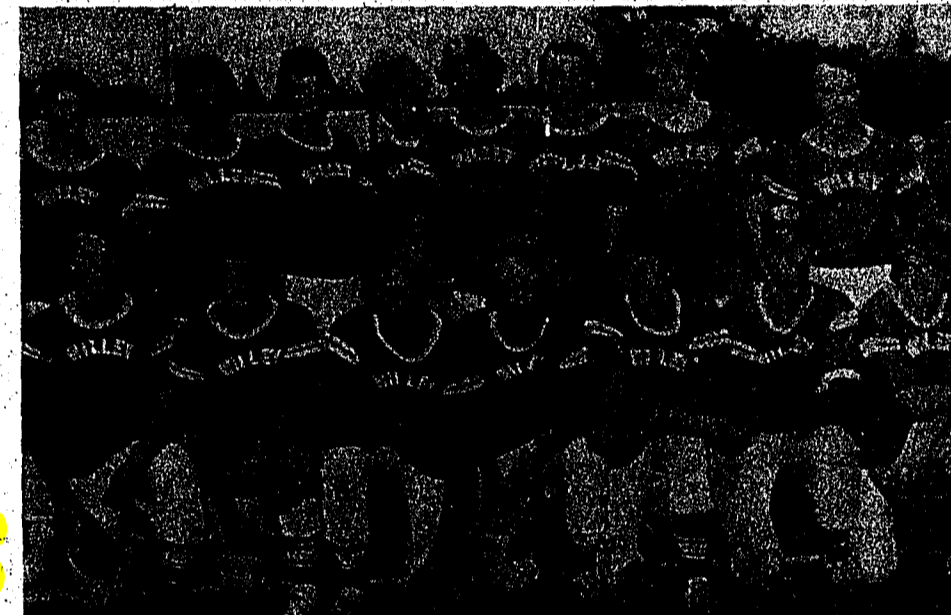
