Parseghian, who compiled a 95-17-4 record and two national championships in 11 seasons as Irish coach, originally injured his right hip as a player with the Cleveland Browns in 1949. "It was in an exhibition game," Parseghian recalled during an interview on Wednesday. "I was carrying the ball and somehow got off kilter and had a partial dislocation of the hip."
