

Carroll opens league season with win at Perry

PERRY - Carroll scored two runs in each of the first, third and fifth innings and backed a three-hit complete game by pitcher Greg Schulz for a 6-2 win over Perry Wednesday night.

Schulz gave up two earned runs on three hits, walked two and fanned eight for the Tigers, now 3-1 overall and 1-0 in Raccoon River Conference play.

"Greg had both pitches working well tonight and kept the Perry hitters off balance," Carroll assistant coach John Semprini said. "The defense played great, committing no errors. The infield made the plays and Marc (Hempstead) played a great defensive game behind the plate."

Chase Steinkamp and Matt Fleshner each pounded out three hits for Carroll at the plate. Steinkamp had a double, two singles and two rbi. Schulz had a rbi double. Ben Gossett, Addison Patrick and Adam Klocke each added singles.
