

Tigers beat Carlisle in league baseball

Carroll defeated Carlisle 3-1 in Raccoon River Conference baseball Tuesday night.

Jake Landon pitched the first five innings for the win, giving up one unearned run on five hits while striking out four and walking one. Michael Dirx threw the final two innings for the save, giving up no runs on no hits and striking out four. The Tigers had three errors in the field.

Addison Patrick, Landon and Dirx were each 2 for 3 at the plate for the Tigers, who improved to 19-* on the season. Dirx had an inside-the-park homerun and a RBI. Landon drove in two runs.

"We're hitting as well as we have all year and at this time of year that's all you want," Carroll coach Dirk Troutman said.
