Requirements for World Cultures Web page!!

Your project must be at least five pages or six pages with a group of three. The topics for each page are:

Page 1: INTRODUCTION PAGE

A Title Page which includes a title, a picture(s), a paragraph explaining why you chose to research this country, a short introduction of the country written in your own words, and links to the other four pages in your project.

Page 2: ALL ABOUT THE COUNTRY in your own words.

Facts about the country and culture, for instance: language, population, religion, etc. Also including interesting details that others may not know about. You need to go in-depth on this page and in paragraph form.

INCLUDE ON THIS PAGE LINKS TO AT LEAST 4 OTHER INFORMATIVE WEB SITES.

Page 3: POINT OF VIEW STORY in your own words to be used for podcast. You will pretend you are in that country to tell a story of culture or current events. A list of questions will be provided to guide you through the page. Insert images of the culture or situation occurring in the country.

Page 4: YOU DECIDE what to include on this page.

For example, if I was doing a project on Spain, I may include clothing, music, body language, or ways of doing business in that country. You should discuss this with Ms. McCaulley before you decide.

Page 5: BIBLIOGRAPHY

Where you got your information and images from. You must have at least 6 resources. You will use an online resource to help you with citation.

Page 6: ONLY REQUIRED WITH GROUP OF THREE

Technical Requirements: You must include the following to receive full credit for your project. To really do a great web page, you need to go above and beyond these requirements!!!

1.	Five pages
2.	Links from your title page to each of the other pages
3.	Links between all pages
4.	Anchors from the bottom of each page to the top of each page
5.	At least 10 images that work with your topic chosen
6.	On page 2, Links to 4 other sites that you feel are good informational sites

7. At least one animation						
8. Background music created in Garageband on at least one page						
9. An embedded video or link to a video						
10. Link to a podcast.						
11. At least one table. A good place to use this would be in your links to other

12. One link that is a picture or image

You must take notes and write all information in your own wordsKEEP						
TRACK OF THE WEB SITES THAT YOU ARE PULLING INFORMATION FROM.						
Not all web sites are accurate, BE CAREFUL!! DO NOT JUST CUT AND						
PASTE TO A WORD PROCESSING DOCUMENT.

you will use in your project: (2-3 days)						
Make sure all backgrounds and images coordinate so that the person						
viewing your web page will find it easy to read and easy on the eye.
